DUI Arrest

On March 15th, 2019 at approximately 4:24 P.M., the Oldham County Police Department was contacted by an official from the Oldham County Board of Education. Oldham County Police was notified that one of their bus drivers, Lesley Harvey of Crestwood, KY had been involved in a non-injury collision and alcohol was suspected.

Oldham County Police responded, and after conducting their investigation and speaking with Ms. Harvey arrested her for:

- One count Operating a Motor Vehicle U/influence of Alcohol
- One count Failure to Report an Accident
- One count Leaving the Scene of an Accident
- 33 Counts of Wanton Endangerment

Ms. Harvey was transported to the Oldham County Detention Center.

The investigation revealed that Ms. Harvey struck several security poles at the entrance of a subdivision on her bus route with 33 students on board the bus. Ms. Harvey reported to her supervisor that she had struck something, but there was no damage and was continuing on her route. No students were injured in the collision, and the bus sustained minor damage. Oldham County Schools had the driver stop, responded to her location, and as is their policy took her to the hospital for a breath test. Oldham County Police was contacted and responded to the hospital.
