Amazon Incident

On May 23, 2019, at approximately 2:20 PM the Oldham County Police Department received a call from an employee of Amazon. The victim reported delivering a package to a residence located in the 2300 block of Spann Lane. Upon backing out of the driveway, he stated his tires “spun some in the loose gravel”. The victim then stated a resident at this address Kenneth Vance DOB 06/15/1955, came out of the residence, pointed a gun at him, ordered him out of the vehicle, and demanded his keys. Mr. Vance left briefly, returned with a rake, and ordered the victim to fix his driveway. After the driveway was fixed, the victim was allowed to leave.

Mr. Vance was detained while officers applied for and were granted a search warrant. Police recovered several handguns and subsequently arrested Mr. Vance for the charges of Wanton Endangerment 1st degree and Unlawful Imprisonment 1st.

Mr. Vance was transported to the Oldham County Detention Center.
