Shooting Investigation Update – Crossbrook Drive Incident

After requests for information were broadcast by area news organizations, Oldham County Police received anonymous tips, as well as photos of a vehicle believed be related to the Crossbrook incident. Using this information Detectives have developed a person of interest in the January 29th shooting on Crossbrook Drive in Pewee Valley. The identity of a person of interest is not being released at this time. The investigation into both shootings remains active, and we ask that anyone with information on the vehicle in the photos below contact the Oldham County Police Department. *Those wishing to remain anonymous can use our online contact form.*

Original Media Release

Over the weekend Oldham County Police responded to two separate calls where a person was shot. Both occurred in residential neighborhoods, involved victims on foot being shot near the street, with witnesses describing a dark colored sedan at the scene. Victims were transported to University Hospital for treatment of injuries that medical personnel described as non-life threatening.

Saturday, January 28, 2023

At approximately 10:00 P.M. Oldham County Police responded to Baptist Health La Grange regarding a 22-year-old male shooting victim in the emergency room having been shot in the upper leg. Officers determined that the shooting occurred on Marilyn Court in the Lakewood Valley neighborhood when an occupant of a dark colored sedan fired several shots from the vehicle at the victim and another bystander.

Sunday, January 29, 2023

At approximately 6:00 P.M. Oldham County Police responded to Crossbrook Drive in Pewee Valley regarding a 15-year-old male being shot twice in the lower back. Witnesses described a dark colored sedan leaving the area immediately after several gunshots were heard.

Despite similarities, investigators believe these are separate incidents regarding the specific parties involved and do not present a continued threat to the community.

Additional vehicle information, names of victims or suspects, and possible motives for the shootings are not currently available for release. The investigation continues into both shootings. The Oldham County Police Department requests anyone who may have information to contact us.
