Fatal Pedestrian Collision

On May 12, 2018 18, at approximately 06:02 AM the Oldham County Police Department, North Oldham Fire Department, and Oldham County EMS, responded to the 11800 block of US 42 (near mile point 4), on a report of a vehicle collision involving a pedestrian.

Preliminary investigation shows that a 2013 Ford Fusion, operated by Corey Christensen of Louisville, was w/b on US 42. The operator of the Fusion reported he encountered an e/b truck and that the lights from the truck were shining in his eyes. The driver of the Fusion averted his eyes to the side of the road, and upon looking back to the roadway saw the pedestrian in the middle of the w/b lane. The pedestrian, Gary Ferraro of Goshen, KY, was jogging on us 42. Mr. Ferraro was struck by the Fusion. Mr. Ferraro was transported by Oldham County EMS to the University of Louisville Hospital, where he subsequently died.

The collision is still under investigation by the Oldham County Police Collision Reconstruction Unit.
